MIXING

Unless instructed otherwise by plant protectant label:

3. Add SPRAY-FAST® last while filling and agitating tank.

Pesticide manufacturers may recommend a rate of nonionic surfactant to be used with their product. Follow the pesticide or active ingredient label recommendations on use of surfactant. However, if the pesticide or active ingredient label does not have a specific recommendation for surfactant use but does not prohibit the use of a nonionic surfactant, SPRAY-FAST® should be applied at the rates listed below. Careful observation of spray performance in a trial application with the combination of chemicals to be applied is recommended to determine proper and efficient surfactant rates.

Fertilizers and micronutrients	4 – 32 fl. oz.
